There will be a late fee of \$5 per day assessed for any art work not picked up by March 31. Artwork that the artist has not arranged to retrieve by March 31 will be considered abandoned and will be disposed of by Arts Unlimited.

Eligibility Rules (Strictly Enforced)

- Artist must be 18 or older
- 2D or 3D original artwork executed in past 12 months
- Prints of original art are ineligible
- Work must not exceed 36 inches in any direction including frame or other supports
- Work over 50# or specialized installation will be artist's responsibility to install and take down
- No hazardous materials
- Work must be framed and ready to hang with wire hangers only – NO Saw tooth hangers
- Questionable supports will not be hung
- Glass breakage is artist's responsibility
- No copies or duplication of existing artwork or
- Photographs, as this infringes on copyrights
- Show has limited space and will be closed when full or February 15, whichever comes first
- Work, if created as part of a class, must contain little or no instruction input
- Labels are made in advance. **No substitution/change of artwork or title at registration will be allowed.**
